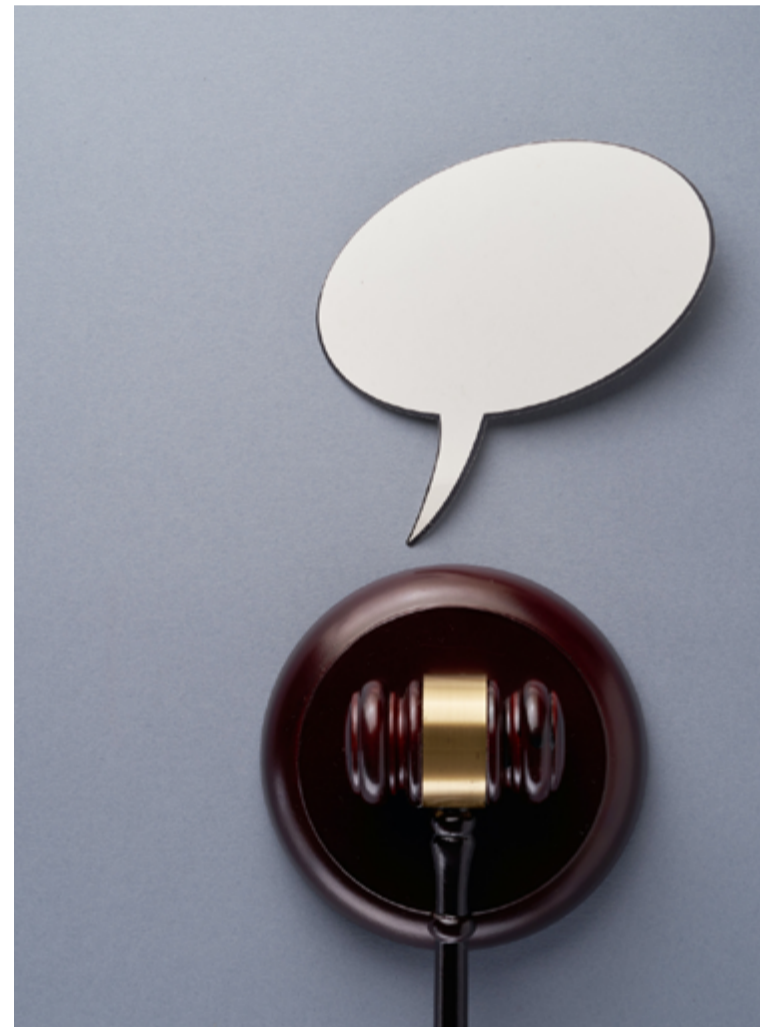
Who is the Guardian of Free Speech? Meta's Oversight Board and (Other) Courts and Dispute Resolution Mechanisms

The spread of misinformation and hate speech has led some to call for a more active role of social networks in curating content. Others fear censorship and arbitrariness. Private companies, such as Meta, have responded to these calls by setting up an internal, yet independent oversight board. European courts have also intervened more frequently in the content moderation process. We shall discuss the relationship between state courts and emerging private dispute resolution mechanisms and their effect on freedom of speech online.
