Judge Paulo Pinto de Albuquerque has held his term of office at the European Court of Human Rights since April 2011 (Portugal). He is a full Professor in the Faculty of Law at the Catholic University of Lisbon since 2015. Professor Pinto was, among others, an Adjunct Professor at the Illinois College of Law in the United States in 2009 and 2010, an invited Professor at the High Military Studies Institute of the Portuguese Ministry of Defence from 2007-2009 as well as a Visiting Professor at the Jiao Tong University in Shanghai, China in 2006. He was a Judge in the Criminal Court and the Correctional Court of Lisbon and a Judge in the Courts of Nelas, Lagos and the Criminal Instruction Court of Lisbon as well. Judge Pinto was also an expert of the Group of States against Corruption (GRECO) appointed by the Council of Europe.
