Privacy Policy

The Editorial Team of the Max Planck Encyclopedia of Public International Law (MPEPIL) is committed to protecting your personal information and complying with the [EU General Data Protection Regulation \(EU 2016/679\)](#) (GDPR). This privacy policy explains how we do this using both the MPEPIL Editorial Manager online system, provided by the American company Aries Systems Corporation and hosted in the United States, and a tailor-made online collaborative work platform hosted in Heidelberg, in collaboration with our publishing partner Oxford University Press (OUP) (United Kingdom/United States).

HOW & WHICH PERSONAL INFORMATION IS COLLECTED

In the context of the MPEPIL project, the personal information we collect includes:

- First names
- Last names
- Emails

We obtain the personal information about the data subject from public websites or seminars, meetings, public events or other personal interactions (e.g. exchange of business cards). Sometimes, we get these contact details directly from the data subject.

WHY & HOW WE USE YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

In order to manage the editorial workflow of the MPEPIL project, we use your personal information in our two online systems in the following ways:

- To suggest authors for each entry
- To invite authors and receive their response
- For contractual purposes between the author and the publisher (OUP)
- For authors to submit entries
- To review submissions
- To submit entries, using an SFTP server, to OUP, via the Editorial Manager online system

Your personal information is only disclosed to the following categories of recipients:

- MPEPIL editorial team (general editor, managing editor, senior editor, student assistants)
- Academic advisory board members
- Publishing partner: OUP ([OUP Privacy Policy](#))

If you do not consent to the storage and use of this personal information, we will not be able to include you in the project.

GIVING AND WITHDRAWING YOUR CONSENT

We will ask for your consent when it is required for us to process your personal information.

You have the right to withdraw that consent. Should you want to withdraw your consent and be removed from the MPEPIL databases, you can do it anytime by contacting us at mpepil@mpil.de.

UPDATING YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

In order to keep your personal information as accurate as possible, you have the ability to view and update your user information at any time by logging into the MPEPIL Editorial Manager online system.

STORING YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

Your personal information is stored in the EU, the UK and in the US. The MPI Heidelberg and our cooperating partners, Aries Systems Corporation (US) and OUP (UK/US), implement appropriate safeguards and technical measures to protect your personal data. The transfer of data from MPI Heidelberg to the US is based on the [EU-US Data Privacy Framework](#). The transfer to the UK is based on adequacy decisions by the EU Commission.

We will only keep records of your personal information for as long as is reasonably necessary for the purposes of the MPEPIL project.

INFORMATION ON THE PROCESSING OF YOUR DATA AND YOUR RIGHTS

In accordance with Chapter 3 GDPR 'Rights of the data subject', authors, reviewers and other contributors which are included in the MPEPIL online systems have, in particular, the right:

- To be informed
- To access
- To rectify
- To delete
- To oppose to treatment
- To limit the treatment
- To ask for the data portability of the private data concerning her or him
